Women's Voices Now is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization using film to drive positive social change that advances women's and girls' rights globally.

WHAT DO WE DO?

We move audiences from **empathy to action** by promoting, producing, and sharing social-change films.

PROMOTE

Our film festival promotes female filmmakers making social-change films to advocate for women's and girls' rights around the world. 680 filmmakers from 65+ countries have submitted their films to our festival.

PRODUCE

Our Girls' Voices Now program empowers female and femme-identifying youth from low-income communities to find, develop, and use their voice for positive social change through filmmaking.

SHARE

Our free film archive raises awareness of the struggles and triumphs of women and girls around the globe, inviting audience members to support women's and girls' rights through films in 40+ languages.

GLOBAL RECOGNITION



Since 2017, we have held special consultative status to the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC). Our work is internationally recognized for impacting six of the UN Sustainable Development Goals (UN SDGs).

Women's Voices Now envisions a **global culture shift** in which communities and institutions believe in the value of gender equality, and adapt their behaviors and actions to support systematic advancement of women's and girls' rights.
